GOOD MANUFACTURING PRACTICES

Bio-Energy Systems, Inc is required to follow an FDA regulation known as Current Good Manufacturing Practices (cGMP). The cGMP regulation helps our company ensure the safety, purity, and quality of our products. To assure compliance with cGMP, please observe the following:

- No food or drink is allowed in any production area.
- Smoking is prohibited inside the building.
- Before entering a production area, use the hand sanitizer located in all transition rooms.
- Lab coats and hair coverings (Protective Gear) must be worn in all designated areas.
